# STREET CHILD CRICKET WORLD CUP

## CAMBRIDGE & LONDON 2019

30 APRIL – 8 MAY 2019



Ahead of the 2019 ICC Cricket World Cup in England and Wales, the first Street Child Cricket World Cup (SCCWC) will unite street-connected children from across the world to play in an international cricket tournament, representing their countries and the millions of children still living on the streets.

**THE FINAL OF THE SCCWC WILL BE HELD AT LORD'S CRICKET GROUND, THE HOME OF CRICKET, ON TUESDAY 7 MAY 2019.**

Street Child United has a unique and proven model – we use the power of sport to provide a global platform for street children to be seen and their voices heard. Ahead of the world's biggest sporting competitions, we organise international sports events for street children to change the negative perceptions and treatment of all street children worldwide.

Over 9 days, former street children from 10 countries will play a Street20 cricket tournament delivered in partnership with The Change Foundation, and will participate in a unique model-UN Congress for street children's rights. The children will speak as Ambassadors addressing the specific issues they face and make recommendations to protect street children's rights worldwide.

This will be our first major event in the UK, with activities taking place across venues in Cambridge and London, and the first ever Street Child Cricket World Cup – join us to be part of this landmark moment, using the power of sport to help street children to have their voices heard and to challenge the way that the world sees and treats all street children.
